Challenge_

With their Microsoft file server heading towards decommission, Derbyshire Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust needed to migrate their data in the fastest, most effective and least disruptive way possible.



Plan

As Microsoft SharePoint accredited experts, boxxe devised a plan to move the existing user and shared network data on the file server into SharePoint and OneDrive using Quest Essentials.



Approach_

We ran data analytics through Quest to identify the quantity, age and viability of their data. We moved the data with next-level security measures, by migrating personal network data to OneDrive, and shared network data to Microsoft Teams.



We've now future-proofed their data, ahead of the Microsoft 2012 server shutdown. Trust stakeholders also have the tools to take ownership of their data, and with the data filed in different groups within Teams, each department head holds responsibility for it – no more running to IT when you can't get the right access.
