CHALLENGE 01

Trusted technology that has been in service for 50+ years.

CHALLENGE 02

Fairly reliable coverage due it's on premise transmitters .



CHALLENGE 03

One of our most important systems. (Albeit it with very little governance).



The Myth. Hospital would not be able to function without it.





The Scale of the Challenge

- 2 Trusts
- 7 Hospitals
- 2 Bleep systems
- 5449 bleep devices
- Lack of governance in issuing devices and adding them to emergency response teams
- Lack of reporting capabilities

- 'It's too risky to change how we do crash calls.'
- 'Nothing could be as simple and effective as a bleep.'
- 'Bleeps are cheap and reliable.'
- 'They last forever and they don't run down.'
- 'WiFi is just not good enough in hospitals'



How we tackled it?





The Roll Out

Early Engagement

Surveys and other tools allowed us to be clear about which areas wanted Trust devices and which wanted BYOD.

02

Now your Emergency Teams

Once your routine user roll out is complete, it's time to do the emergency teams and introduce dual running.

Identify User Base

01

Auditing our existing systems at 3 monthly intervals allowed us to remove thousands of non existent bleep numbers.

Routine Users Go First

03

Routine users in this context mean nonemergency bleep holders.


Roll out complete - BAU

05

Once emergency teams have transitioned and assurances met on coverage functionality. Turn off old bleep systems.



Just one Tonne of CO2e

"Preventing emissions is orders of magnitude easier than trying to fix the problem afterwards."

"Behind me you can see the volume of 1 tonne of CO2 at atmospheric pressure."

"It's enormous.

In a few hours long flight, we can often emit that amount (per passenger!!).

However, to remove that much CO2 from the atmosphere for example, with #DACCS (direct air capture and storage), you need to pump that much air 35,000 (thirty-five thousand) times through a 20% efficient device."
